- E-book




#### Online risks for children

- Content harmful or not appropriate to watch
- Coercion and extortion by the predators searching for children on social media, gaming and other platforms for sexual purposes
- Grooming
- Cyberbullying
- Sexting
- Games with gambling like elements
- Privacy concerns & digital footprint
- Dark web



#### Negative health effects

- Sleep
- Obesity
- Mental health: Depression, anxiety, fear
- Cognitive development delay
- Language delay
- Social emotional problem
- Digital eye strain
- Risky health behaviors



## Tips for parents

- Parent digital media use-Be a role model
- Make your own family media use plan
- Talk to them and include them in making rules
- Set limits-use parental settings, programs like Common sense media
- Screen free zones and times
- Limit Screen time –No screen for less than 2 years except for video chatting
- 18-24 months co viewing, supervised
- > 24 months less than 1-2 hrs per day



### Tips for parents

- Older children-personalized plan with 8-12 hr sleep, 1 hr physical activity and time away from devices.
- Co viewing
- Talk about Digital footprint
- Talk about being good digital citizens
- Pay attention to their mental health
