To conceptualize child development as a holistic matter through various domains such as social, emotional, cognitive, physical and spiritual for lifelong learning and wellbeing.











Objectives of the Course

To cover child development stages from conception to eight


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




To familiarize course participants with the ECD content material that is relevant, research oriented and authentic.









Duration of the Course

Course Work

This course lasts for 16 sessions (including group presentations) and uses a blended learning approach, consisting of three elements:
